

VISIT DECLARATION

In compliance of the Safety, Occupational Health and Environmental Policies of Anglo American Chile, we inform you about the major Risks found at the sites of our Operational Divisions and the Preventative Measures to be followed for your protection, within the framework of our “Zero Damage” Vision.

MAJOR RISKS AND HAZARDS.

- Running over, collision or toppling of heavy and light vehicles.
- Trapping by moving machinery in industrial areas.
- Hearing damage due to Noise Exposure.
- Respiratory Damage due to Dust Exposure.
- Electrocution due to contact with electric cables.
- Crushing due to Suspended Load Falls.
- Damage due to Flying Particles.
- Fainting or Altitude sickness due to fatigue or lack of oxygen.
- Intoxication or burns due to contact with Hazardous Substances.
- Burns due to contact with Metals and Hot Slag.
- Injuries due to falls from the same or different level.
- Damage due to Explosives Blasting.
- Trapping due to slope slides and avalanches.
- Intoxication or asphyxia due to gases.
- Burns due to solar UV Radiation.

PREVENTATIVE MEASURES.

- Attend to an induction talk or watch the Risk Induction video tape of the respective Division, as applicable.
- Wear personal protection equipment (hard hat, safety shoes, safety glasses, earplugs, gloves, respirators and others, as applicable).
- Immediately notify any physical or health problem. Example: high blood pressure, fatigue, headache, deafness, breathing difficulty, and other problems you are aware of.
- Respect signs and only move through authorized areas.
- Always be with staff appointed by the Division. You are not authorized to move alone.
- Do not pass under suspended loads.
- Do not intervene electric systems or equipment.
- Only carry out the activity required by the visit.
- You are not authorized to drive, except if the respective Division issues an internal driver's license.
- If you have an internal driver's license, once you have reached your destination point or your contact in the operation, you must always have someone accompanying you. Your vehicle must comply with 100% of the requirements and specifications to go into the Division.
- You CAN'T use mobile phones or Wireless Phones or other similar devices while you drive or while you carry out active or passive working activities.
- You can only use radios in vehicles that have an easy-access voice activated or button activated hands-free system in the gear shift lever or similar.
- To go into Los Bronces Division, you must have a medical certificate describing you are fit to work at 2500 meters above sea level.
